Second Annual Philosophy Student Colloquium

Papers are invited for the second annual Philosophy Student Colloquium of the New Mexico-West Texas Philosophical Society, to be held in conjunction with the Society's 61st annual meeting in Abilene, Texas, March 26-March 28, 2010. The conference will be held at the MCM Elegante; 4250 Ridgemont Dr; Abilene, TX79606. The Student Colloquium is scheduled on Saturday, March 27, 2010.

The Student Colloquium is open to any undergraduate, or first year graduate student. Papers submitted can be on any topic of serious philosophical concern and are to be limited to 1,500 words. The deadline for submissions is Monday, February 15th, 2010. Following the deadline, all submissions will be reviewed and a selection will be made, with notifications sent to all no later than Friday, February 26, 2010. It is the committee's intent to accommodate as many of the student papers submitted as possible. The format for paper presentations will be the same as that adopted for the colloquium's inaugural session this past March, back to back with discussion to follow.
